## SPECIAL PROVISION FOR REMOVE AND REPLACE EXISTING FENCE

## **Description:**

This specification is for removing a portion of an existing fence to allow for construction of new ADA Ramps and replacing that portion of fence after the new concrete sidewalk and concrete ADA Compliant Ramps have been constructed. All existing fencing removed in such a manner shall be re-installed in the same location from which it was removed. This includes, but is not limited to, saw cutting, removing existing fence and posts, storing fence and posts, re-installing fence posts and fence, and replacing any fencing damaged or lost during construction. Any fencing or fence posts lost or damaged during construction shall be replaced at the expense of the Contractor.

The Contractor shall only remove and replace the requisite amount of existing fencing to allow for construction of the new ADA Ramps and sidewalk. The Contractor shall obtain the approval of the Engineer for the amount of fence to be removed prior to construction.

The Contractor shall obtain approval of the Project Engineer for the completed fence installation work before contractor leaves site.

## Method of Measurement and Basis of Payment

The completed work as described shall be paid for at the contract unit price for the following contract item (pay item):

Remove and Replace Existing Fence will be measured as feet. The contract unit price "Ft" shall be payment in full for furnishing necessary labor, equipment and materials required to remove and replace existing fencing where shown on the plans or as directed by the Engineer.
