Conveys lands in Township of Ecorse described as (1) all that part of Lots 9 & 10 of Moore and Moore's Subdivision of front concession of P.C. 259 bounded south by line beginning at point on west line of Ecorse Avenue distant North 29 Degrees East 59/100 of a foot from the line between said Lots 9 & 10 & 10' extending South 78 Degrees 33 Minutes West across said Lots and North by line parallel with said last line and distant therefrom 66 feet.

(2) all the right title and interest of said 1st parties in and to said Ecorse Avenue as laid out on the plat of said Moore and Moore's Subdivision. .  
The 2 parcels of land hereby conveyed being a strip 66 feet wide across and 53 feet along the lands of said 1st party for a highway, to take the place of the South Dearborn Road as now constituted and is to be used for highway purposes only and said land is to revert to 1st parties their heirs and assigns whenever said highway shall be vacated or discontinued by any legal authority.
