Whereas, Section 38-6-4 of the 1984 Detroit City Code provides that, whenever the Director of the Department of Public Works (formerly the Department of Environmental Protection and Maintenance) finds that the safety, health, property and general welfare of the public is endangered by floodwater caused by the rising level of the water in canals, rivers, navigable streams or similar places in the City of Detroit, and that immediate action is necessary to protect such public interests, he shall notify the riparian owners thereof at their address given in the last assessment roll to immediately provide adequate barriers, dikes, or other embankments to protect against the overflow of floodwater, and, likewise, shall post a notice upon every lot, building, or structure thereon; and

Whereas, In accordance with Section 38-6-4 of the 1984 Detroit City Code, the Director of the Department of Public Works notified by first class mail on March 3, 1997 the riparian owners of the following real property to immediately provide adequate barriers, dikes, or other embankments to protect against the overflow of floodwater:

Whereas, Section 38-6-4 of the 1984

Detroit City Code provides that, where any such riparian owner has failed to provide adequate barriers, dikes, or other embankments to protect against the overflow of floodwater, the Director of the Department of Public Works with the approval of the City Council, shall proceed to provide such barriers, dikes, or other embankments; and

Whereas, Due to increment weather over the last several days, there has been an overflow of floodwater onto various of the above-delineated real property which, due to inaction of certain owners thereof, may require the Director of the Department of Public Works to provide adequate barriers, dikes, or other embankments to protect against the overflow of floodwater upon certain of the above-delineated real property;
