Sec. 104.31. CALLED INSPECTIONS: It shall be the duty of the building official to inform the applicant in writing, at the time of application for permit, the stages of construction at which inspections are to be made and the manner in which calls for inspection are to be made.

Not more than four called inspections shall be required.

It shall be the duty of the holder of a permit or his authorized agent to call for inspections at such times and manner as designated by the building official and construction shall not proceed without the written approval of the building official.

It shall be the duty of the building official in response to called inspections either to give a written approval to proceed with construction or give written notice to the owner or owner's agent of the manner in which the building or structure has failed to comply with the requirements of the Building Code.
