pushing the department to know why the work is not being hurried along. On some of the lands abutting the alleys where sewers are to be built, stores and dwellings are in course of construction, with cellars filled with water and no drainage. The department asks that something be done as soon as possible to relieve the situation, and respectfully suggests that the matter be referred to the Committee on Sewers, which can arrange a meeting between the men and the contractors to try to solve the difficulty and permit this very important work to proceed. to proceed.
