

**From Sinking Fund Commission.**

To the Honorable, the Common Council:

Gentlemen—A meeting of the Detroit City Sinking Fund Commission was held Wednesday, 11:30 a. m., November 27th, 1912, at the Wayne County Savings Bank, the following commissioners being present:

Thompson, Heineman, Vernor, Tossy, Lodge and Deputy City Treasurer Eauman, acting for Commissioner Koch.

The City Treasurer delivered to the Commissioners one hundred seventy-two (172) Special Assessment Bonds, Nos. 5421 to 5592, amounting to \$207,591.76. The Bonds were verified by number and amount and, having been found correct, were accepted and placed in the strong box.
