Bancroft and Joy avenues, to Joy Road.
Scotten avenue—North of Joy Road, to Quincy avenue.
Vinewood avenue—North of Joy Road, to Holmur avenue.
Arlington avenue—North of Joy Road, to Wildermere avenue.
Elmhurst avenue—Nardin to Livernois, to Woodbine avenue.
Tuxedo avenue—Nardin to Livernois, to Lawn avenue.
Algonquin avenue—South of Plymouth, to Bryden avenue.
Blanche avenue—North of Grand River, to Bryden avenue.
