Sewers

To the Honorable the Common Council:
Gentlemen—To your Committee
on Sewers was referred the communi-
cation from the Department of Pub-
lic Works transmitting proposals for
the construction of extension of Mc-
Dougall avenue sewer; Edlie street
sewer (from Lycaste to alley west of
Glover), and Edlie street sewer (from
Fairview to alley east of Engel). Al-
so communication re-referred by the
Committee on Ways and Means rela-
tive to deficiency in the appropri-
ations on these same sewers. Beg to
report that we have had the mat-
ter under consideration, and are satis-
fied that there will be no advantage
to the city to readvertise for the con-
struction of these sewers, at this
time, and your Committee recom-
mends that the Department of Public
Works be directed to enter into con-
tract with the lowest bidder in each
case, also that the Controller be di-
rected to transfer from the Public
and Lateral Sewer Assessment Ac-
count the sum of \$4,736.26, to make
up the deficiency in the appropri-
ations for the construction of these
sewers, and therefore offer the fol-
lowing resolution.
