To the Honorable the Common Council: Gentlemen—To your Committee of the Whole was referred the petition of Robert Oakman (1119), for the acceptance of deed of property described as North 15 feet of lot 45 and South 15 feet of lot 120, Robert Oakman's 15 feet of lot 120, Robert Oakman's Alta Vista Sub. for the purpose of widening entrance to Fullerton avenue for street and highway purposes. Your committee finds that this property consists of two strips, 15 by 100 feet, and if accepted would increase the width of said street at Twelfth street from 60 to 90 feet.
