Gentlemen:-In conformity with action of the Board of Education at a meeting held November 25th, 1919, certain property on the southwest corner of the Burton School Site was authorized deeded to the City of Detroit to remedy the traffic situation at the corner of Peterboro and Cass Avenues.

In deeding this property to the City of Detroit for the purpose intended, the Board of Education specifically provided that the City construct at this point a cement safety zone at least 6" curb height, 12ft. across the front on the Cass Avenue end and tapering gradually to a point in the direction of Woodward Avenue.

In this connection permit me to state that under date of February 25th, 1922, Inspector H. H. Jackson, Division of Traffic Duty, Department of Police, addressing a communication to T. Glenn Phillips, Consulting Secretary, City Plan Commission, in which he states states that "the width of the safety zone seems to cover a greater area than would be necessary to accommodate pedestrians who would cross at this intersection, and I believe could be reduced and the additional space given over to street area.
