Resolved, That it be and is hereby declared by the Common Council of the City of Detroit necessary to make in said City the following described improvement, and that the same is for the use or benefit of the public, viz..

Opening of Hurlbut avenue, between Sterritt avenue and alley first south thereof, where not already open, as a public street and highway.

That they deem it necessary to take private property for the purpose of making such improvement, which said property is situated in said City of Detroit, and is bounded and described as follows:

All that part of lot 10 of Cooper's Subdivision of part of Fractional Sections 22 and 23, T. 1, S. R. 12 E., as recorded in Liber 26, page 42 of Plats of Wayne County Records, described as follows: Beginning at the northeasterly corner of said lot. Thence along the easterly line of said lot south 26 deg. 28 min., west 2.46 feet to a point. Thence along a line north 5 deg. 25 min., west 2.88 feet to a point on the northerly line of said lot. Thence along said line in a southeasterly direction 1.53 feet to the place of beginning.

Also all that part of lot 11 of last mentioned subdivision described as follows: Beginning at a point on the northeasterly corner of said lot. Thence along the easterly line of said lot south 5 deg. 25 min., east 53.88 feet to a point. Thence along a line south 26 deg. 28 min., west 20.00 feet to a point on the southerly line of said lot.
