E. ¼ of the N. E. ¼ and the south 2 acres of the West ½ of the N. E. ¼ of the N. E. ¼ of Sec. 11, T. I. S. R. 12 E., as recorded in Liber 45, page 39, of Plats of Wayne County Records,
