Which said roll has been prepared pursuant to and in accordance with the resolution adopted by the Common Council December 14, 1926; further resolved, that the description of the premises and the names of persons contained therein are received as correct, that the lots and parcels of land contained therein and the several owners and occupants have been assessed in said roll in proportion to the benefits specially derived by them, and each of them, from the widening of said St. Stephens Ave.; that the benefits of such improvement to such lots and parcels of land, and the several owners thereof, equals the assessment levied against the property contained in said assessment roll; that the benefits to the whole of the property included in the taxing district equals the sum assessed thereon, and that the sums set forth in the said assessment roll are the correct ones which each lot or parcel of land should be assessed and pay, and that the said assessment upon such lot or parcel of land, be collected from the several persons liable to pay the same according to law, and shall become due and payable within 60 days from the date of the first publication by the City Treasurer of the notice of said assessment.
