Resolved, That deed of Huron Farms Company covering property dedicated for street purposes described as "All that part of private claim 667 described as follows: Beginning at a point on the southeasterly line of South Dix avenue where it intersects the easterly line of South Coolidge Highway (120 feet wide), said point being distant North 32 deg. 00 min. east 77.47 feet and South 18 deg. 39 min. East 38.67 feet from the intersection of the Private Claim line common to Private Claims 259 and 667 and the center line of Coolidge Highway, 120 feet wide; thence along the southeasterly line of Dix Avenue North 32 deg. 06 min. 45 sec. East 1044.32 feet to a point on the southwesterly line extended of the Michigan Central (D. D. & D.) Railroad Right-of-Way; thence along said Railroad line South 57 deg. 57 min. 45 sec. East 1.04 feet to a point; thence along a line being 33 feet southeast of and parallel to the line common to Private Claims 259 and 667 South 32 deg. 00 min. West 1046.87 feet to a point on the easterly line of Coolidge Highway (120 feet wide) thence along the easterly line of Coolidge Highway North 18 deg. 39 min. West 4.01 feet to the place of beginning, containing .049708 acres to be used for street and highway purposes only. If said property ceases to be used for street and highway purpose, it shall

revert to, and again be a part of the property from which it is now taken."

Rudell, his wife, to the City of Detroit covering property dedicated for street purposes described as "The northerly twenty (20) feet of lot 153, the westerly 6 feet of the southerly 20 feet of lot 153 and the westerly six feet of lot 154 of Moses W.
