Resolved, That "the southerly 11 ft. of public alley, adjoining the northerly line of lot 122 of Corliss and Andrus Boulevard Park Sub. of part of fractional Sec. 1, T. 2 S. R. 11 E., and fractional section 36, T. 1 S. R. 11 E., as recorded in Liber 23, page 57 of Plats of Wayne County Records, said 11 ft. of alley lying between the easterly line of Wabash ave. (60 ft. wide) and the easterly line of alley first easterly thereof," be and the same is hereby vacated to become a part and parcel of the adjoining property.

Provided, Petitioner deeds to the City of Detroit for alley purposes "the northerly 11 ft. of lot 123 of said Corliss and Andrus Boulevard Park Sub." and further

Provided, That by reason of the vacation of the above described alley the City of Detroit does not waive any right in the lateral sewer located therein, and shall at all times have the right to enter upon the premises if found necessary on account of said sewers to repair same, and provided further, that petitioner shall not build over the above described alley without first securing the approval of the City Engineer and the Board of Health, and further

Resolved, That the City Controller be and he is hereby directed to execute quit-claim deed covering the property herein vacated.
