Resolved, That consent be and is hereby granted to the Board of County Road Commissioners of Wayne County, Michigan, to take sufficient jurisdiction over the Base Line or Eight Mile Road from the northeast city limits at Kelly Road westerly to Van Dyke Road and from Woodward Avenue westerly to the Northwestern Highway to enable said Board of County Road Commissioners to maintain said road.

Provided, however, the said City of Detroit hereby reserves to itself the control, occupation and use of said Base Line or Eight Mile Road, within the limits of said city for public travel thereon, and uses thereof as the said city now has or may hereafter have necessity to use the same, and for the legitimate purposes and uses granted or hereafter to be granted by said City to any public utility and as fully in those regards as though this resolution had not been adopted.
