Resolved, That quit-claim deed of the Detroit Library Commission to the City of Detroit covering property dedicated for street purposes described as "A portion of the parcel of land in Sec. 7 of Governor and Judges Plan of the City of Detroit as recorded in Liber 34, Page 544 of Deeds of Wayne County Records; bounded by Farmer, Library and Gratiot aves., being the easterly 11 ft. adjoining the westerly line of Library ave., the westerly 11 ft. adjoining the easterly line of Farmer st. and certain parcels adjoining the present northerly line of Gratiot ave., and also a triangular parcel at the northwesterly corner of the Library site, more particularly descibed as follows: beginning at the intersection of the northerly line of Gratiot ave. 60 ft. wide, with the westerly line of Library ave., 60 ft. wide; thence on a course S. 77 deg. 58 min. 12 sec. W. 16.41 ft. to a point; thence S. 38 deg. 14 min. W. 181.96 ft. to a point; thence S. 58 deg. 59 min. 30 sec. E. 17.96 ft. to a point on the present north line of Gratiot ave.; thence along the northerly line of Gratiot ave. N. 36 deg. 03 min. E. 192.46 ft. to the place of beginning.

W. 392.18 ft. to its intersection with the easterly line of Farmer st., 60 ft. wide; thence along the said line of Farmer st. S. 30 deg. 0 min. E. 383.70 ft. to a point; thence S. 59 deg. 52 min. E. 39.58 ft. to a point; thence N. 58 deg. 59 min. 30 sec. W. 17.96 ft. to a point; thence on a line 11 ft. east of and parallel to the easterly line of Farmer st., 60 ft. wide, N. 30 deg. 0 min. W. 308.75 ft. to a point; thence N. 45 deg. 02 min. 30 sec. E. 27.05 ft. to a point; thence on a line 11 ft. west of and parallel to the westerly line of Library ave., S. 59 deg. 55 min. E. 286.42 ft. to a point; thence N. 77 deg. 58 min. 12 sec. E. 16.41 ft. to the point of beginning," be and the same is hereby accepted and the City Controller be and he is hereby directed to record said deed in the office of the Register of Deeds for Wayne County.
