Resolved, That quit-claim deed of the Detroit Edison Co. to the City of Detroit covering property dedicated for alley purposes, described as "all that part of lots 139 and 140, block 1 of Christy's Subdivision of part of Fractional Sections 22 and 23, T. 1 S. R. 12 E., City of Detroit, according to the plat thereof, recorded in Liber 23 of Plats on page 47, Wayne County Records, described as follows—beginning at a point on the easterly line of a 20 ft. alley as conveyed to the City of Detroit by the Dime Savings Bank by deed dated June 5, 1928, and recorded in Liber 2954 of Deeds on Page 377, Wayne County Records, and by Huron Farms Co. by deed dated June 11, 1928 and recorded in Liber 2954 of Deeds on page 381, Wayne County Records, said point being 17.79 ft. northerly of the point of intersection of the southerly line, extended easterly, of lot 7, block 1 of said subdivision with the easterly line of said 20 ft. alley; thence northeasterly along a curve to the right, having a radius of 47.01 ft. and central angle of 50 deg. 55 min., 41.77 ft. to a point on the northerly line of said lot 139, being the southerly line of an east and west alley 18 ft. wide, said point being 7.62 ft. westerly of the northeasterly corner of said lot 139; thence westerly along said northerly line of said lot 139, being tangent to the above described curve, 22.38 ft. to the place of beginning."

Also, quit-claim deed of the Huron Farms Co. to the City of Detroit covering property dedicated for alley purposes described as "all that part of lots 10 and 11, block 1 of Christy's Subdivision of part of P. C.'s 257, 337 and 725 and part of Fractional Sections 22 and 23, T. 1 S. R. 12 E., Wayne County, Michigan, as recorded in Liber 23, page 47 of Plats of Wayne County Records, more particularly described as follows—beginning at a point in lot 10 of last mentioned subdivision, said point also being in the north line of 18 ft. public alley north of and parallel to Harper ave. and being distant S. 77 deg. 09 min. west 14.37 ft. from the intersection of the said north line of said east and west public alley with the west line of north and south 18 ft. public alley; thence along said line N. 77 deg. 09 min. east 14.37 ft. to said point of intersection; thence along said west line of said north and south public alley N. 11 deg. 03 min. west 14.37 ft. to a point on lot 11 of last mentioned subdivision; thence along a line S. 33 deg. 03 min. west 20.64 ft. to the place of beginning."

Also, warranty deed of the Burton-Dixie Corporation to the City of Detroit covering property dedicated for street and alley purposes, described as "the northerly 11 ft. and the easterly 30 ft. of the following described premises—a parcel of land lying between and adjoining the Grand Trunk Railroad right-of-way and Klenk's Van Dyke avenue Subdivision, between and adjoining J. Calvert's Sons Van Dyke Avenue Subdivision, and the Hafeli-Tumey Subdivision, being a part of the S. ½ of the S. ½ of the N. ½ of the N. E. ¼ of Sec. 16, T. 1 S. R. 12 E., City of Detroit, Wayne County, Michigan, and being more particularly described as follows: beginning at the northeast corner of Sec. 16, T. 1 S. Calvert's Sons Van Dyke Ave. Sub., as recorded in Liber 54, page 59 of Plats, Wayne County Records, 877.81 feet to a point on the easterly line of the Grand Trunk Railroad right-of-way at this date 99.00 ft. wide; thence N. 30 deg. 25 min. 46 sec. east and along said easterly right-

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of-way line 380.35' ft. to a point on the southerly boundary line of the Hafeli-Tumey Subdivision as recorded in Liber 61, page 9 of Plats, Wayne County Records; thence N. 89 deg. 45 min. east along the southerly boundary line of the Hafeli-Tumey Sub. and said line extended, in a direct line (said line being also the north line, of the S. 1/2 of the S. 1/2 of the N. 1/2 of the N. E. 1/4 of said Sec. 16) easterly 684.97 ft. to the northwest corner of Klenk's Van Dyke Avenue Sub. as above mentioned; thence S. 00 deg. 03 min. east along the easterly line of said Klenk's Van Dyke Avenue Sub., 328.10 ft. to the place of beginning, containing 5.87824 acres of land."
