Alley Dedication

To the Honorable, the Common Council:

Gentlemen—To your Committee of the Whole was referred petition of Edward J. Tisdelle (8722), offering to dedicate land for alley purposes north of Van Buren Ave. between Carlin Ave. and Schaefer Highway. After consultation with the City Plan Commission, and careful consideration of the matter, your committee recommends that the offer be approved, and the deed accepted, with the understanding that the alley must be graded at petitioner's expense. Resolved, That deed of Edward J. Tisdelle to the City of Detroit covering property dedicated for alley purposes, described as "all that part of lot 4 of Robert M. Grindley's Subdivision No. 8 of Little Farms of part of the N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 6, T. 2 S., R. 11 E., as recorded in liber 31, page 13 of Plats of Wayne

County Records, more particularly described as follows: beginning at a point on the southerly line of said lot 4, said point being the westerly corner of lot 1 of the north-division of part of lots 5 and 6 of Robert M. Grindley's Sub. No. 6 of Little Farms of part of the N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 6, T. 2 S., R. 11 E., as recorded in liber 64, page 21 of Plats of Wayne County Records; thence along the northerly line of said subdivision S. 85 deg. 45 min. 04 sec. west 20 ft. to the northeasterly corner of lot 12 of last mentioned subdivision; thence along the easterly line of said lot, also being the westerly line of public alley, 20 ft. wide as platted in last mentioned subdivision extended North 4 deg. 40 min. west 80 ft. to a point on the northerly line of lot 4 of Robert M. Grindley's No. 6 subdivision heretofore mentioned; thence along the said northerly line North 85 deg. 45 min. 04 sec. east 20 ft. to a point; thence along a line South 04 deg. 40 min. east 80 ft. to the place of beginning, be and the same is hereby accepted, with the provision that the grading of said alley shall be done at petitioner's expense, and further
