Resolved, That the quit claim deed of Walter Woodbridge and Ruth M. Woodbridge, his wife, to the City of Detroit covering property dedicated for street purposes, described as:

The west 50 feet of the southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 12, T.1.S.R. 10 E., lying east of and adjoining the easterly line of Forrer Avenue 50 feet wide as platted in Rugby Boulevard Subdivision of part of the east $\frac{1}{2}$ of the S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 12, T. 1 S. R. 10 E, City of Detroit and Redford Township, Wayne County, Michigan as recorded in Liber 50 page 56 of Plats of Wayne County Records and lying between a line 60 feet north of and parallel to the south section line of the southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of said section 12 and a line 43 feet south of and parallel to the north section line of the southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of said section 12 except Outer Drive, 150 feet wide as opened. To be used for street purposes and known as Santa Maria Avenue.

R. 10 E., lying between a line 50 feet easterly of and parallel to Rugby Boulevard Subdivision, heretofore mentioned and the westerly line of Beechurst sub. of part of E. $\frac{1}{2}$ of N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 12 T. 1, S. R. 10 E., Redford Twp., Wayne Co., Mich., as recorded in Liber 44 page 93 of Plats of Wayne County Records and being a continuation of Thatcher Avenue, 50 feet wide as platted in said Beechurst sub. To be used for street purposes and known as Thatcher Avenue.

Also a strip of land 43 feet wide in said Southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 12, T. 1. S. R. 10 E., lying south of and adjoining the north $\frac{1}{4}$ section line of the southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 12 and between a line 50 feet easterly of and parallel to Rugby Boulevard Subdivision heretofore mentioned and the westerly line of Beechurst sub. heretofore mentioned. To be used for street purposes and known as Curtis Avenue.
