I therefore suggest the adoption of the following resolution, so that the amount held by the City of Detroit may be turned over to Floyd A. Frye, Public Administrator and Special Administrator of the Estate of Mary Holmes, deceased, with the exception of \$877.06, which the City of Detroit claims it has coming from this fund for welfare relief.

This, of course, is held subject to the outcome of probate proceedings and the determination of the Commission on Claims.
