Gentlemen: I am in receipt of a Quit Claim Deed from the State Land Office Board, pursuant to the resolution of your Honorable Body, Au-

gust 17, 1943, J.C.C. 2201, covering the following properties:

East 100 feet lying West of and adjoining Wyoming Avenue North of and adjoining St. Martins Avenue, 30 feet wide of the North 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 of Section 5, Town 1 South, Range 11 East, West side of Wyoming, Ward 16.

Gentlemen—The following employees of the City of Detroit were injured while in the course of their employment:

James Brennan, Clare Gorton, employees of the Department of Public Works.

Under the terms of the Michigan Workmen's Compensation Law, the employer shall pay the injured employees at the rate of 66 2-3 per cent of their average weekly wages, not to exceed \$21 per week, nor more than 750 weeks, from the date of injury.
