Gentlemen—I am in receipt of a quit-claim deed from Frank M. Foster and Eudora B. Foster covering a 20-foot strip of land for the widening of Evergreen Road.

This strip is a part of the old Vetal School site which was recently sold by the Board of Education. As appears by the minutes of the Board of Education for October 9, 1945, the Committee of the Whole of the Common Council requested that the westerly 20 feet be allocated for the widening of Evergreen Road.

The entire parcel was deeded to Frank M. Foster and Eudora B. Foster who in turn deeded the 20-foot strip to the City with the provision that if this strip is not used for street widening within 15 years it shall revert back to them.

Deed having been approved by the Corporation Counsel, resolution accepting same is attached.
