Gentlemen—I am in receipt of a deed from the Detroit Trust Company, as Successor Trustee under the will of David Gray, deceased, covering property described as

"A triangular portion of lot 274 of Oakwood Boulevard Manor Subdivision of part of P. C. 671, Detroit Wayne County, Michigan, as recorded in Liber 53 of Plats, on page 89, Wayne County Records, more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the northeasterly line of said lot 274 with the westerly line of said lot; thence along said westerly line of said lot south 28 degrees 64 minutes 10 seconds west 30 feet to a point; thence along line south 70 degrees 5 minutes 20 seconds east 50.99 feet to a point in the northeasterly line of said lot 274, said line also being the southwestwesterly line of Lowdell Avenue 60 feet wide
