ment is particularly interested in having this done so that some of the social factors entering into the employment picture can be evaluated at this time. An outline of the final report from the Project will be prepared by the representative of the School of Social Work.

May we take this opportunity to again emphasize the enthusiastic cooperation which has been given to the Department of Public Welfare by all of the agencies that have been asked to give us counsel and advice and also have been asked to give experience and valuable time to this demonstration project.

We are sincere when we say that never in our experience in the Department has there been an expression of such a desire to assist in a concrete way, and we want you to know how much we appreciate the time and effort that has been put into this Project by the representatives of these agencies.

As soon as the medical reports, psychological reports and evaluation of these individuals has been made on a few cases, we plan to call a meeting of representatives of the Department of Governmental Research, Detroit Citizens League, Employers Association of Detroit, Michigan Manufacturers Association, Board of Commerce, Automobile Manufacturers Association, the Citizens Planning and Housing Council and other interested individuals to discuss particular questions of job location for the clients who have been classified as "fully employable" by this group of experts, and to explore the possibilities of protected employment for those clients who are not fully employable on the present labor market.

We have already contacted executives of the above organizations and they have agreed to discuss this problem with us as soon as practical.

We shall keep you informed on future progress and appreciate your interest in this activity of the Department.
