Re: 17124 Schaefer between McNichols and Santa Maria, Common Council Petitions No. 6931 and No. 1289.

Gentlemen—On October 21, 1947, your Honorable Body granted a six month extension for the maintenance of a frame real estate office located at 17124 Schaefer Road. In granting this petition, your Honorable Body required petitioner to file a bond to cover the cost of the removal of said office should petitioner not remove same after the expiration of six months or when ordered by the Common Council.

It is respectfully recommended that the Department of Public Works be directed to dismantle and remove the building and that the Corporation Counsel be directed to contact the Bonding Company for the purpose of collecting costs of the work involved.

Gentlemen—In accordance with a communication from your Honorable Body, the City Plan Commission has made an investigation relative to the request of the Board of Wayne County Road Commissioners to dedicate a parcel of City-owned property for the widening of Southfield Road.

The property is described as follows: The westerly 56 feet of Lot 12,

Brookline Subdivision, on the west side of Southfield between McNichols and Outer Drive. The parcel was obtained through foreclosure proceedings and is necessary to effect the widening and grade separation plans for Southfield Road for which property is now being acquired by the Wayne County Road Commission.

In view of the above circumstances, it is the opinion of the City Plan Commission that there would be no objection to granting this request. The Commission, therefore, recommends that the above described parcel be conveyed to the Board of Wayne County Road Commissioners for use in connection with the widening of Southfield Road.
