No. 1 of the N. $\frac{1}{5}$ of the N. $\frac{1}{2}$ of the S. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ and N. $\frac{1}{5}$ of N. $\frac{1}{2}$ of W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of S. W. 30 ft. to a point; thence along a line N. 2 deg. 18 min. 05 sec. W., 386.61 ft. to the place of beginning.

St. Martins ave. All that part of the N. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 3, T. 1 S., R. 10 E., City of Detroit, Wayne County, Mich., described as follows: beginning at a point distant N. 87 deg. 40 min. 50 sec.
