To the Honorable, the Common Council:

Gentlemen—In response to our advertisement for proposals to furnish the Election Commission with Steel

Folding Chairs, seven (7) bids were received as per the attached tabulation.

The lowest acceptable bid was submitted by American Seating Company of Detroit, who agrees to furnish 1200 Steel Folding Chairs, Model 43, on the basis of \$3.60 each, and acceptance of their bid is recommended.

This price is F.O.B. delivered and is firm.

Lower bids of \$2.60 each and \$2.65 each, both on Durham Model 605, are not acceptable as the sample chair submitted shows rough edges and that the chair is not well braced nor is it sufficiently sturdy. Another lower bid of \$3.40 each on Clarin Model 318W is not acceptable as a steel seat is specified and the sample chair submitted has a wooden seat which from department experience is not as durable nor as comfortable. Also the molding around the seat is raised and would be liable to snag hose.
