To the Honorable, the Common Council:

Gentlemen: In response to our advertisement for proposals for furnishing this Department with Cleaner Compound, in accordance with specifications on file in this office, bids were received and opened October 5, 1948 as per the attached tabulation.

The lowest evaluated bid was submitted by the Northwest Chemical Company and it is recommended that we be permitted to accept their bid for furnishing Cleaner Compound on the following basis:

- 15,000 lbs. Metal Cleaner, No. 70. at \$10.64 cwt.
- 2,850 lbs. Emulsifier V-E at \$21.03 cwt.; f.o.b. delivered.

A two-week test was conducted by our Engineering Division and although the original cost of the
