Gentlemen—The following described parcels presently owned by the City of Detroit, are located within the limits of the right-of-way of the John C. Lodge Expressway. In order to make them available for this project, we request that title thereto be transferred to Charles M. Ziegler, as State Highway Commissioner.

The west 25 feet of Lot 7, Block 6, Subdivision of the LaBrosse Farm so called lying between the Chicago & Grand River Roads, into City Lots, in the Western Addition to the City of Detroit, Wayne County, Michigan, as recorded in Liber 14 of Deeds, on Pages 414, 415 and 416, Wayne County Records.

Being the lands conveyed to the City of Detroit by Warranty Deed dated May 25, 1855, and recorded in Liber 58 Page 684, Wayne County Records, and by Warranty Deed dated July 23, 1864, and recorded in Liber 109 Page 176, Wayne County Records.

The south 40.33 feet of Lot 2, Block 6, Subdivision of the La Brosse Farm so called lying between the Chicago & Grand River Roads, into City Lots, in the Western Addition to the City of Detroit, Wayne County, Michigan, as recorded in Liber 14 of Deeds, on Pages 414, 415 and 416, Wayne County Records.
