**Re: Water Main Extension, Peti-
 tion B-5122 (forced petition).**

Council:
 Gentlemen—A recent investigation
 has revealed a short supply of water
 in the block on Melrose Avenue from
 East Grand Boulevard to Custer Ave-
 nue, which is presently supplied by a
 substandard 4-in. main.

A forced petition, therefore, has
 been issued for the installation of a
 6-in. main to replace the 4-in., in-
 volving the laying of approximately
 570 linear feet of pipe. This will
 necessitate an assessment levy of
 \$1,219.00 against the benefitted front-
 age.

Will your Honorable Body kindly
 adopt the attached resolution, declar-
 ing a necessity for the work and
 authorizing levy of assessment in con-
 formity with City Ordinance.
