Re: Petition No. 5258: Water Main Extension.

Gentlemen—A petition has been received from John M. Hammell, 4838 Pennsylvania Avenue, for extension of water main for service to his property, Lot No. 812 of Yorkshire Woods Subdivision No. 4, in Kingsville Avenue from Alstead Avenue to Tyrone Avenue.

The petition involves the laying of approximately 900 linear feet of 8-in. pipe. The petitioner has paid the assessment in the amount of \$130.99, which covers his property involved. It will be necessary to prepare an assessment roll spreading the balance of \$411.96 against the remaining frontage, making the total assessment for the extension \$542.95.

Will your Honorable Body kindly adopt the attached resolution, declaring a necessity for the work and authorizing levy of assessment in conformity with City ordinance.
