Resolved, That quit-claim deeds of Peter M. Cundari, et al, dedicated for alley purposes, described as "All that part of the Southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 27, Town 1 South, Range 10 East, City of Detroit, Wayne County, Michigan more particularly described as follows; Beginning at a point in the east line of Braile Avenue, 60 feet wide as now established, said point being distant north 0 degrees 49 minutes west, 127 feet from the northeast corner of Braile Avenue, 60 feet as now established and Plymouth Avenue, 86 feet wide as now established; thence along the east line of said Braile Avenue, north 0 degrees, 49 minutes, west 21.28 feet to a point; thence north 60 degrees, 10 minutes, 36 seconds, east 124.48 feet to a point; thence north 89 degrees, 44 minutes, east 253.13 feet to a point; thence south 69 degrees, 33 minutes, 47 seconds, east 127.27 feet to a point; thence south 1 degree, 06 minutes, 04 seconds, east 20 feet to a point; thence south 89 degrees, 44 minutes, west 3.65 feet to a point; thence north 69 degrees, 33 minutes, 47 seconds, west 127.27 feet to a point; thence south 89 degrees, 44 minutes, west 246.12 feet to a point; thence south 69 degrees, 10 minutes, 36 seconds, west 128.16 feet to the point of beginning."
