Resolved, That quit-claim deed of Goodwin's Inc., a Michigan Corporation, to the City of Detroit covering property dedicated for street widening purposes, described as "A parcel of land being a part of Lots 17, 18 and vacated alley (18 feet wide) situated between Lots 17 and 18 of Robert Oakman Land Company's Grand River and Oakman Highway Resubdivision, of Lots 2 and 3 of the Subdivision of the E. 1/2 of the N. W. 1/4 Sec. 33 and Lots 25 to 34 inclusive, and part of Lots 35, 36 and 37 of The Maplegrove Subdivision of Lot 4 of the Subdivision of the E. 1/2 of the N. W. 1/4 of Sec. 33 and part of the S. W. 1/4 of Sec. 28, T. 1 S., R. 11 E." City of Detroit, Wayne County, Michigan, more particularly described as: Beginning at the intersection of the northerly line of Roselawn Avenue (50 feet wide) with the easterly line

of Oakman Boulevard (150.00 feet wide); thence North 18 deg. 05 min. East, along the easterly line of Oakman Boulevard, 7.00 feet to a point; thence South 71 deg. 55 min. East, parallel to the northerly line of Roselawn Avenue, 111.36 feet to a point; thence South 60 deg. 35 min. East, 43.91 feet to a point on a curve on the northerly line of Roselawn Avenue; thence northwesterly, along the northerly line of Roselawn Avenue on a curve to the left, 16.50 feet, measured along the arc of said curve, to a point of tangent, said curve having a radius of 83.40 feet and a central angle of 11 deg. 20 min.; thence North 71 deg. 55 min. West, continuing along the northerly line of Roselawn Avenue, 138.02 feet to the point of beginning. Containing 904.0 square feet of land, to be used for street purposes."

Be and the same is hereby accepted and the City Controller is hereby directed to record said deed in the office of the Register of Deeds for Wayne County.
