Honorable Common Council:

Gentlemen—We are returning herewith the petition of the Board of Education, Number 6225, requesting the vacation of the southerly 8.00 feet of the east-west public alley, 20 feet wide, west of Baldwin Avenue between Charlevoix and Goethe Avenues in connection with the construction of the Bell School. The vacation of said portion of alley was approved by the City Plan Commission with the recommendation that an additional 8.00 feet be dedicated on the northerly side of the alley to maintain a 20-foot width. The petition was then referred to this office by your Committee of the Whole for investigation and report.

We wish to advise that our investigations are completed.

We are in receipt of a Quit Claim Deed to the City of Detroit deeding land for alley purposes. Said deed was approved as to form and execution by the Corporation Counsel and as to description by the City Engineer, and is attached for your Honorable Body's acceptance.

All City departments and private-owned utility companies reported that they will be unaffected by said vacation or that they have reached satisfactory agreements with the petitioner regarding their installations therein.

We recommend the adoption of the attached resolution.
