Resolved, By the Common Council of De roit that it is deemed necessary to construct vitrified crock lateral sewers in the following alleys, to-wit:

Lateral Sewer No. 5,098 in blocks bounded by Robson, Ardmore, Seven-Mile Road, Outer Drive;

Lateral Sewer No. 5,116 in blocks bounded by Mackay, Harned, S. of Eight-Mile Road, Eight-Mile Road;

Lateral Sewer No. 5,117, in blocks bounded by Faust, Southfield, Tireman, Bonaparte;

Lateral Sewer No. 5,118, in blocks bounded by Burt, Pat.on, Lyndon, Fenkell;

Lateral Sewer No. 5,119, in blocks bounded by Patton, Kentfield, Lyndon, Fenkell;

Lateral Sewer No. 5,120, in blocks bounded by Ridgedale, Blackstone, Puritan, Verne;

Lateral Sewer No. 5,121, in blocks bounded by Sorrento, Steel, Pilgrim, Puritan.

And it is hereby declared that this action is had under sections 42 and 43 of chapter 1, title 1, of the Charter of 1893, authorizing the Common Council to direct and regulate the construction of lateral sewers or drains for the purpose of more effectually draining all lots or celars, yards and sinks, whenever in their opinion the same shall be necessary.

Resolved, That for the purpose of assessmen. for defraying and paying the cost of said vitrified crock lateral sewers, the lots and parcels of real estate within the limits of each of said alleys and abutting thereon through which each of the said lateral sewers is ordered to be construced, as set forth and described in the plat thereof submitted by the Department of Public Works, shall be and the same is hereby constituted and declared to be one local assessment district for the lateral sewer so constructed.

Resolved, That the City Engineer be and he is hereby ordered and directed to make an assessment on the lots and parcels of real estate within the limits of each of said lateral sewers and abutting thereon according to the benefit said lots and parcels of real estate shall receive from said improvement.

Resolved, That the Department of Public Works be and is hereby ordered to advertise five times for proposals for constructing said lateral sewers.

To the Honorable, the Common
Council:

Gentlemen—Under date of Novem-
ber 6, 1912, J. C. C. page 1597, your
Honorable Body granted permit to
allow an encroachment of two porches
on Waterloo Street, now Vernor High-
way, six feet over the lot line, at the
southeast corner of Sheridan Avenue.

Setting back of the curb for the widening of Vernor Highway, requires that this permit be cancelled. I am attaching hereto request from the present owner of the property, for permission to maintain these present porches, for a distance of four feet over the property line, in order that entrance to the building may not be wholly destroyed. The cutting off of two feet of the porches referred to will leave sufficient distance between the curb and the property line for the construction of a six foot sidewalk.

In view of the unusual conditions involved, I respectfully recommend that the original permit be revoked and that a new resolution be adopted, granting permission to occupy four feet of the street, as herein outlined. Attached is a blue print showing present conditions in relation to the new curb line.

By Councilman Walters:

Resolved, That the Department of Public Works be and is hereby authorized and directed to issue a permit to Madeline Lareau to reconstruct two porches at the southeast corner of Sheridan ave. and the Vernor Highway, same to encroach not more than 4 feet over the lot line.

Provided, That said work shall be performed under the supervision of the Department of Public Works in accordance with plans submitted to and approved by said Department.

Provided, That no rights in the public streets, alleys or other public places shall be considered waived by this permission which is granted expressly on the condition that said porches and all obstructions in connection therewith shall be removed at the expense of the grantee at any time when so directed by the Common Council, and that the public property affected shall be restored to a condition satisfactory to said Department by said grantee at its expense; and further

Provided, That said permit issued by the Department of Public Works is granted with the distinct understanding that in the event of the Charter of the City of Detroit being amended in such manner as will provide for the levying of a fee, charge or rental, to be hereafter determined upon, or in the event of an ordinance or resolution being enacted providing for an annual charge or rental for the occupancy of public streets, alleys or other public places, that the grantee will pay said fee, charge or rental provided for in said charter, or ordinance or resolution, and that said grantee does hereby bind himself thereunto and to accept said permit on the conditions hereby imposed, and in the event of the said grantee contesting the validity of said Charter amendment, ordinance or resolution or of said fee, charge or rental, or upon refusal to pay same, this permit shall immediately become void; and further

Provided, This resolution is revocable at the will, whim or caprice of the Common Council and grantee hereby expressly waives any right to claim damages or compensation for property constructed hereunder or for the removal of same, and further, that grantee acquires no implied or other privileges hereunder not expressly stated herein.

To the Honorable, the Common Council:

Gentlemen—I am returning herewith petition No. 4352, Harry J. Mayheu, et al, for relief of inadequate drainage conditions in the alley in rear of 14th Avenue between Antoinette and McGraw.

Sewers in this block are congested and should be relieved. In order to accomplish this end, the department proposes to construct a relief arm in Antoinette Street from the alley east of 15th Street to the public sewer in 16th Street. The estimated cost of this improvement is \$1,800.00.

I respectfully request your Honorable Body to authorize the department to make the above improvement, and charge the cost thereof to Lateral Sewer Arm Fund.
