Resolved, That the Department of Public Works be and is hereby authorized and directed to issue a permit to Kazimiera Krzymanski to complete alterations to theatre building at Moran st. and Ferry ave. with an encroachment of 8 in. over the line into Moran st.

Provided, That when said building is removed or remodeled same shall be reconstructed on the proper lot lines with no encroachments on the public streets or alleys, and further

Provided, That if at any time in the future it is necessary to widen Moran street, petitioner shall not make any claim for damages or compensation for the portion of the building encroaching on said street as granted by this resolution, and further

Provided, That the granting of this permit shall not be construed as establishing a precedent, and if at any time in the future, the conditions on the street shall change, and other property owners request permission to construct or maintain encroachments on the public street, the petitioner herein shall be required to remove the encroachment at the theatre building, permission to maintain which is herein granted, without expense to the City of Detroit, and further

Provided, This resolution is revocable at the will, whim or caprice of the Common Council, and grantee hereby expressly waives any right to claim damages or compensation for property constructed hereunder or for the removal of same, and further, that grantee acquires no implied or other privileges hereunder not expressly stated herein.
