Areaways

To the Honorable, the Common Council:

Gentlemen—To your Committee of the Whole was referred petition of

the Federal Reserve Bank of Chicago (5725), to construct an areaway under the sidewalk in the north side of W. Fort St. between Griswold and Shelby Sts. After consultation with the Dept. of Public Works, City Plan Commission, and careful consideration of the request, your committee recommends that same be granted in accordance with the following resolution.

By Councilman McNamara:

Resolved, That the Dept. of Public Works be and it is hereby authorized and directed to issue permit to the Federal Reserve Bank of Chicago, to construct an areaway in public property under the sidewalk, in the north side of W. Fort St. between Shelby and Griswold Sts., same being an extension of basement in connection with the construction of new building on the east 25 ft. of lot 14, lot 15, and the west 40 ft. of lot 16, of the Military Reserve; said areaway to extend from the property line 9½ ft. into W. Fort St., by 115 ft. long and 15 ft. deep.

Provided, That prism light shall not be installed in the sidewalk, and that said work shall be performed under the supervision of, and in accordance with plans submitted to and approved by the Dept. of Buildings & Safety Engineering and the Dept. of Public Works, and that petitioner shall pay for any damage that may occur to public property during such construction or at any time thereafter, and further

Provided, that no rights in the public streets, alleys or other public places shall be considered waived by this permission, which is granted expressly on the condition that said areaway and all obstructions in connection therewith shall be removed at the expense of the grantee at any time when so directed by the Common Council, and that the public property affected shall be restored to a condition satisfactory to said Department by said grantee at its expense, and further

Provided, that said permit issued by the Department of Public Works, is granted with the distinct understanding that in the event of the Charter of the City of Detroit being amended in such manner as will provide for the levying of a fee, charge or rental, to be hereafter determined upon, or in the event of an ordinance or resolution being enacted providing for an annual charge or rental for the occupancy of public streets, alleys or other public places, that the grantee will pay said fee, charge or rental provided for in said Charter, or ordinance or resolution, and that said

grantee does hereby bind himself thereunto and to accept said permit on the conditions hereby imposed, and in the event of the said grantee contesting the validity of said Charter amendment, ordinance of said Charter or of said fee, charge or resolution or upon refusal to pay same, this permit shall immediately become void, and further

Provided, this resolution is revocable at the will, whim or caprice of the Common Council and grantee hereby expressly waives any right to claim damages or compensation for property constructed hereunder for the removal of same, and further, that grantee acquires no implied or other privileges hereunder not expressly stated herein.
