Resolved, That the Dept. of Public Works be and it is hereby authorized and directed to issue permit to General Motors Corporation, to construct a concrete tunnel 7 ft. high by 4½ ft. wide, for the purpose of installing in said tunnel, steam lines, water mains, compressed air lines and electrical transmission lines, across Farnsworth Ave., the center line of said tunnel to be located 37 feet 6 inches east from the easterly line of Riopelle St., connecting with petitioner's property on the north and south sides of Farnsworth Ave.

Provided, The said work shall be performed under the supervision of the Dept. of Public Works and the Dept. of Buildings & Safety Engineering, and in accordance with plans submitted to and approved by said departments, and further

Provided, That grantee accepts such permission with the distinct understanding that the grantee assumes full responsibility for any and all claims or damages which may arise by reason of the granting of said permit, and further

Provided, That no rights in the public streets, alleys or other public places shall be considered waived by this permission, which is granted expressly on the condition that said tunnel for utility lines and all obstructions in connection therewith shall be removed at the expense of the grantee at any time when so directed by the Common Council, and that the public property affected shall be restored to a condition satisfactory to said department by said

grantee at its expense, and further provided, That said permit issued by the Department of Public Works, is granted with the distinct understanding that in the event of the Charter of the City of Detroit being amended in such manner as will provide for the levying of a fee, charge or rental to be hereafter determined upon, or in the event of an ordinance or resolution being enacted providing for an annual charge or rental for the occupancy of public streets, alleys or other public places, that the grantee will pay said fee, charge or rental provided for in said Charter, or ordinance or resolution, and that said grantee does hereby bind himself thereunto and to accept said permit on the conditions hereby imposed, and in the event of the said grantee contesting the validity of said Charter amendment, ordinance or resolution or of said fee, charge or rental, or upon refusal to pay same, this permit shall immediately become void, and further
