Resolved, That the Dept. of Public Works be and it is hereby authorized an- directed to issue permit to Walter Davison Co., 2660 W. Fort St. between 18th and 19th Sts., to lower an ad-ditional 20 ft. of curbing east of and adjoining existing 20 ft. cut, resulting in a total curb cut of 40 ft. out of 177 ft. for commercial driveway into premises at above address.

Provided, Ordinance grade is used and all sidewalks are replaced to grade, and further

Provided, That said work shall be performed under the supervision of the Department of Public Works, and in accordance with plans submitted to and approved by said department, and further

Provided, That no rights in the public streets, alleys or other public places shall be considered waived by this permission, which is granted ex-pressly on the condition that said

curb cuts and driveway and all ob-structions in conection therewith shall be removed at the expense of the grantee at any time when so directed by the Common Council, and that the public property affected shall be re-stored to a condition satisfactory to said department by said grantee at its expense, and further

Provided, That said permit issued by the Department of Buildings & Safety Engineering, is granted with the distinct understanding that in the event of the Charter of the City of Detroit being amended in such man-ner as will provide for the levying of a fee, charge or rental, to be here-after determined upon, or in the event of an ordinance or resolution being enacted providing for an an-nual charge or rental for the occu-pancy of public streets, alleys or other public places, that the grantee will pay said fee, charge or rental provided for in said Charter, or or-dinance or resolution, and that said grantee does hereby bind himself thereunto and to accept said permit on the conditions hereby imposed, and in the event of the said grantee con-testing the validity of said Charter amendment, ordinance or resolution or of said fee, charge or rental, or upon refusal to pay same, this per-mit shall immediately become void, and further

Provided, This resolution is revoc-able at the will, whim or caprice of the Common Council and grantee hereby expressly waives any right to claim damages or compensation for property constructed hereunder or for the removal of same, and further, that grantee acquires no implied or other privileges hereunder not ex-pressly stated herein.
