Resolved, That the Dept. of Public Works be and it is hereby authorized

and directed to issue permits described, to the following:

Board of Education (6749), to install a 2 in. conduit line and a 1½ in. conduit line from existing Public Lighting Commission pole and fire alarm box located on the south side of Beatrice Ave., east of Leonard St., to extend under and across Beatrice into premises of the Jeffries School, at the N. E. corner of Beatrice and Leonard. Also to install a 2 in. fire alarm conduit line behind the curb for a distance of approx. 60 ft. on the west side of Avon St., north of Puritan, and a 2 in. telephone conduit line under and across Avon St., from existing pole on the east side of Avon., approx. 138 ft. north of Puritan extending to premises of the Cooke School, at the N.W. corner of Avon and Puritan. Provided said lines are encased in concrete at least 3 ft. below the top grade of the street.

Hudson Motor Car Co. (6750), to install under ground electrical conduit line from plant at 10831 Devine St., from existing pole on the north side of Devine St., to their parking lot on the south side of the street. Provided, Same is installed at least 3 ft. below the top grade of the street, and further provided petitioner furnishes an approved surety bond in the penal sum of \$5,000.00, saving and protecting the City of Detroit harmless from any and all claims, damages or expenses that may arise by reason of the issuance of said permit, and provided for the faithful performance by the grantee of the terms hereof, and files same with the City Controller.

Provided, That said work shall be performed under the supervision of the Dept. of Public Works, Dept. of Buildings & Safety Engineering, Public Lighting Commission and Dept. of Streets & Traffic, and in accordance with plans submitted to and approved by said departments, and further

Provided, The entire street width of Devine is available for traffic from 3:00 P.M. to 5:00 P.M. and one lane is available during the remainder of the day, and further

Provided, That no rights in the public streets, alleys or other public places shall be considered waived by this permission, which is granted expressly on the condition that said utility lines and all obstructions in connection therewith shall be removed at the expense of the grantee at any time when so directed by the Common Council, and that the public property affected shall be restored to a condition satisfactory to said Department by said grantee at its expense, and further

Provided, That said permit issued by the Department of Public Works, is granted with the distinct under-

standing that in the event of the Charter of the City of Detroit being amended in such manner as will provide for the levying of a fee, charge or rental, to be hereafter determined upon, or in the event of an ordinance or resolution being enacted providing for an annual charge or rental for the occupancy of public streets, alleys or other public places, that the grantee will pay said fee, charge or rental provided for in said Charter, or ordinance or resolution, and that said grantee does hereby bind himself thereunto and to accept said permit on the conditions hereby imposed, and in the event of the said grantee contesting the validity of said Charter amendment, ordinance or resolution or of said fee, charge or rental, or upon refusal to pay same, this permit shall immediately become void, and further

Provided, This resolution is revocable at the will, whim or caprice of the Common Council and grantee hereby expressly waives any right to claim damages or compensation for the removal of same, and further, that grantee acquires no implied or other privileges hereunder not expressly stated herein.

Provided, Petitioner furnishes an approved surety bond in the penal sum of \$10,000.00, saving and protecting the City of Detroit harmless from any and all claims, damages or expenses that may arise by reason of the issuance of said permit, and providing for the faithful performance by the grantee of the terms hereof, and files same with the City Controller, and further

Provided, That the work shall be performed under the supervision of the Dept. of Public Works, and the Dept. of Buildings & Safety Engineering, and in accordance with plans submitted to and approved by those departments, and further

Provided, That said construction tower and all obstructions in connection therewith shall be removed at the expense of the grantee at the expiration of said period and that the public property affected shall be restored to a condition satisfactory to the Dept. of Public Works by said grantee at its expense, and further

Provided, That this resolution is revocable at the will, whim or caprice of the Common Council and grantee hereby expressly waives any right to claim damages or compensation for property construction hereunder, or for the removal of same, and further, that grantee acquires no implied or other privileges hereunder, not expressly stated herein.
