1. File with the City Controller's Office a surety indemnity bond in the amount of 10,000.00; or

2. File with the City Controller's Office a public liability insurance public liability insurance policy indemnifying the City of De-

troit in the amount of \$10,000.00; or Provided, That said permit shall be issued only after a certified copy of this resolution has been duly recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds by and at the permittee's expense,

for Wayne County; and further Provided, That this resolution is revocable at the will, whim or caprice of the Common Council, and said permittee hereby expressly waives any right to claim damages or compensation for property constructed and/or maintained hereunder or for the removal of same, and further, that permittee shall acquire no implied or other privileges hereunder not expressly stated herein.
