Gentlemen — Returning herewith letter from the Chrysler Corporation requesting an amendment to Petition No. 12025.

On September 21, 1965, J.C.C. Pages 2277-78, your Honorable Body ap-

proved Petition No. 12025 approving the installation of an underground fire line encroachment, consisting of a water main, ten (10) inches in diameter and five (5) feet below grade, for a distance of 540 feet along Hamlet and 900 feet along Mound Road. Due to an expansion program, petitioner is now asking that the permitted encroachment along Mound Road be increased to 1380 feet.

The Department of Public Works recommends this request be granted, provided, the agreement on file with the City Controller's Office be amended to include this request.

Provided, That this resolution is revocable at the will, whim or caprice of the Common Council and grantee hereby expressly waives any right to claim damages or compensation for

property constructed hereunder or for the removal of same, and further, that grantee acquires no implied or other privileges hereunder not expressly stated herein.
