Gentlemen—To your Committee of the Whole was referred petition of Forbes-Cohen Corp. (12311), to install brick type service walk onto public property at Livernois and Norfolk. After consultation with the Department of Public Works, and careful consideration of the request, your committee recommends that same be granted in accordance with the following resolution.

By Councilman Beck:

Resolved, That the Department of Public Works be and it is hereby authorized and directed to issue a permit to Forbes-Cohen Corp., owner of premises at the northeast corner of Livernois and Norfolk, described as Lots 82 through 86, Greenacres Subdivision, to install and maintain a brick type service walk in a 3 ft. area of public property between the existing public sidewalk and the property line on the Livernois Ave. side of said building for a distance of 11 ft. along the street; size of brick to be used to be 4 x 8 x 1½ inches.

Provided, That same shall be constructed and maintained under the rules and regulations of the Department of Public Works in accordance with plans submitted to and approved by that department, and further

Provided, That petitioner shall first file with the City Controller an agreement, inform approved by the Corporation Counsel, wherein petitioner assumes full responsibility for any and all claims which may arise by reason of the construction of said brick type service walk, and that said responsibility shall also include maintenance of said walk by petitioner, its successors and assigns, and further

Provided, That no rights in the public streets, alleys or other public places shall be considered waived by this permission, which is granted expressly on the condition that said brick type service walk and all obstructions in connection therewith shall be removed at the expense of the grantee at any time when so directed by the Common Council, and

that the public property affected shall be restored to a condition satisfactory to said Department by said grantee at its expense, and further

Provided, That said permit issued by the Department of Public Works is granted with the distinct understanding that in the event of the Charter of the City of Detroit being amended in such manner as will provide for the levying of a fee, charge or rental, to be hereafter determined upon, or in the event of an ordinance or resolution being enacted providing for an annual charge or rental for the occupancy of public streets, alleys or other public places, that the grantee will pay said fee, charge or rental provided for in said Charter or ordinance or resolution, and that said grantee does hereby bind himself thereunto and to accept said permit on the conditions hereby imposed, and in the event of the said grantee contesting the validity of said Charter amendment, ordinance or resolution or of said fee, charge or rental, or upon refusal to pay same, this permit shall immediately become void, and further

Provided, This resolution is revocable at the will, whim or caprice of the Common Council and grantee hereby expressly waives any right to claim damages or compensation for property constructed hereunder or for the removal of same, and further, that grantee acquires no implied or other privileges hereunder not expressly stated herein.
