Resolved, That the Department of Public Works be and it is hereby authorized and directed to issue permit to Lee C. Saperstein, Eugene L. Nosar, Paul L. Ringler and Boris Katz, d.b.a. a co-partnership for permission to encroach at 13115 E. Jefferson Avenue, Detroit, Michigan, property being described as:

"Lots 132-135 including Blk. 1, Jefferson and Mack Subdivision of that part of P.C. 689, North of Jefferson Avenue, Liber 18, Page 75, Wayne County Records."

Encroachment to consist of decorative grills over ground floor windows, starting 1½ feet above ground level to a height of 8 feet, encroaching into city property a maximum of 6 inches on both E. Jefferson and Lenox.

Provided, That the necessary permit be obtained from the Department of Public Works and that same shall be constructed and maintained under the rules and regulations of said department, the Department of Buildings and Safety Engineering and the Department of Parks and Recreation in accordance with plans submitted to and approved by those departments and

Provided, That permittee at the time of obtaining said permit file with the City Controller an indemnity agreement in form approved by the Corporation Counsel saving and protecting the City of Detroit harmless from any and all claims, damages or expenses that may arise by reason of the issuance of said permit and the faithful performance by the permittee of the terms thereof, and in addition to pay all claims, damages or expenses that may arise

out of the maintenance of said encroachment; and

Provided, That no rights in the public streets, alleys or other public places shall be considered waived by this resolution which resolution is adopted expressly on condition that said encroachment shall be removed at the expense of the permittee at any time when so directed by resolution of the Common Council, and that the public property affected shall be restored to a condition satisfactory to said Department of Public Works by said permittee at its sole cost and expense; and

Provided, That said permit shall be issued only after a certified copy of this resolution has been duly recorded in the office of the Wayne County Register of Deeds by and at the permittee's expense; and

Provided, That this resolution is revocable at the will, whim or caprice of the Common Council, and permittee hereby expressly waives any right to claim damages or compensation for removal of encroachment and further that permittee acquire no implied or other privileges hereunder not expressly stated herein; and

Provided, That the filing of the indemnity agreement and the securing of the necessary permit referred to herein shall be construed as acceptance of the terms of this resolution by the permittee; and

Provided, That this permit shall not be assigned or transferred without the written approval of the Common Council.
