WHEREAS, the Petitioner, one Marvin Yagoda (Fanny Yagoda), has previously applied for and has been granted an encroachment permit by the City Council, the same being reported in JCC pages , April 12, 1976; and

WHEREAS, the previous encroachment consisted of 82 fiberglass cutouts of assorted bottles to encroach approximately six inches (6") from the face of the building into public property commencing at a height of four feet (4') from the sidewalk grade to the top of the building for a distance of approximately one hundred thirty-five feet (135') along the Fenkell frontage. Encroachment will also include the installation of approximately twenty street lights approximately one foot from the face of the building, not to be in conflict with existing street lighting; and

WHEREAS, the petitioner now requests permission to change the number and the location of the street lights installed;

NOW BE IT RESOLVED, that the Environmental Protection and Maintenance Department be and it is hereby authorized and directed to amend the permit issued to Marvin Yagoda (Fanny Yagoda) to encroach at 14200 Fenkell to allow the installation of nineteen street lights in the public right of way, four lights next to the property line along Fenkell and the remainder between the sidewalk and curb along Freeland Street.

PROVIDED, that the necessary permit be obtained from the Environmental Protection and Maintenance Department and that the same shall be constructed and maintained in accordance with plans submitted to and approved by said Department.

PROVIDED, that all the other terms and conditions of the original grant to encroach shall apply to this amended grant.
