Resolved, That the Building & Safety Engineering and Public Works Department be and they are hereby authorized and directed to issue permits to Broadstreet Medical Inc., 12040 Broadstreet, for an encroachment into the street right-of-way at that address, the property being described as: Lot 329 of Brown & Babcock's Subdivision of the W'y 41½ acres of ¼ Sec. 29 and W'y 25.06 acres of ¼ Sec. 32, 10,000 A T recorded L16 P15 Plats WCR.

Encroachment to consist of a 5'6" wide concrete wheel chair ramp to provide barrier free entrance to the building at the above address, said ramp to encroach 10 feet into the public right of way from the back of the public sidewalk to the easterly right-of-way line.

Provided, that petitioner file with the Finance Department an indemnity agreement approved by the Law Department, saving and protecting the City of Detroit from any and all claims which may arise therefrom; and

Provided, that a permit be obtained from the Department of Public Works.
