Gentlemen—Your Committee on Street Openings, to whom was referred back the resolution presented by Ald. Burton at a session held on the 2nd inst. (J. C. C., p. 120), providing for the vacation of Southern avenue between Hammond and Military avenues, respectfully report that we have again had the matter under consideration and beg leave to state that your Committee can see no objection to vacating said street provided the Michigan Central R. R. Company deeds to the City of Detroit the northerly 46 feet of lots 11 to 20, both inclusive, plat of the sub. of the estate of Stephen Livernois, being part of P. C. 574; and on the further condition that the Michigan Central R. R. Company file an agreement waiving all claims for damages that might accrue to lots 11 to 20, both inclusive, above described, by reason of the proposed separation of grades, and we therefore recommend that the resolution above referred to, presented at a session held on the 2nd inst. (J. C. C., p. 120), be amended by adding the following paragraph thereto:

"And further provided, That the Michigan Central R. R. Company files with the City Clerk within 30 days from the date of the adoption of this resolution an agreement in writing waiving therein all damages that may result or accrue to said company or assignees, insofar as lots 11 to 20, both inclusive, of plat of the sub. of estate of Stephen Livernois, being part of P. C. 574, hereinbefore described, are concerned by reason of separation of grades in the vicinity of Military and Hammond avenues, and said agreement is approved by the Corporation Counsel as being correct in form and execution, and accepted by the Common Council," and that said resolution, as so amended, be adopted.
