AN ORDINANCE to amend Sections 2 and 16 of Article XXXII of an Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance defining the Duties and Powers of the Department of Buildings and the Establishing of a Building Code for the City of Detroit."

It is hereby ordained by the People of the City of Detroit:

Section 2. That Section 2 of an Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance defining the Duties and Powers of the Department of Buildings and the Establishing of a Building Code for the City of Detroit" be, and the same is hereby amended by the addition of the following at the end of the second paragraph:

"Amusement enterprises desiring to use banner signs shall first satisfy the Department of Buildings that the signs to be used will be properly hung and shall give such other assurances as may be desired. All signs in excess of fifteen square feet in area shall be inspected as herein stated; provided, however, that the owner thereof may remove said signs from time to time to change the reading matter thereon and rehang
