

Streets.

To the Honorable the Common Council: Gentlemen—Your Committee on Streets, to whom was referred a communication from the Department of Public Works submitting proposals for paving certain streets and alleys, respectfully report we have had the same under consideration and find that J. Porath is lowest bidder for that J. McGraw avenue with cedar paving on concrete foundation at \$2,337; that J. A. Mercier is lowest bidder for paving Peterson street with cedar block on concrete foundation at \$2,439; that F. Porath & Son is lowest bidder for paving Campbell avenue with cedar block on concrete foundation at \$2,271; that Detroit Asphalt Paving Co. is lowest bidder for paving Vanderbilt avenue with asphaltic concrete (natural lake asphalt) at \$2,580; that Barnes & Zimmerman is lowest bidder for paving alley No. 502 with one-course concrete at \$1,285 and alley No. 503 with one-course concrete at \$1,118; and that R. J. Powelson & Co. is lowest bidder for paving alley No. 506 with one-course concrete at \$1,071 per sq. yd. Your committee being satisfied that the bids submitted are reasonable, recommend that the contracts entered into by the Department of Public Works with the aforesaid lowest bidders be approved and confirmed and that the resolutions Ald. Keating presented at a session held August 10, 1915 (J. C. C., p. 1366-1367), be adopted.
